#### Instructions:

- All stations, be prepared to check in and relay critical reports via our Cherokee ARES SKYWARN NET when established. The Goal is to leverage the Cherokee SKYWARN NET with personnel operating from home as much as possible to run the net. This will free the EOC Team to collect critical reports and relay critical traffic via WEBEOC to Cherokee EMA Team.
- All SKYWARN reports will be on the Cherokee ARES SKYWARN NET/REPEATER or if required the NWS SKYWARN Linked Repeater. Either the SKYWARN NCS or CHEROKEE EOC should direct local reports to NWS SKYWARN if conditions require. We need to avoid double reporting and confusion. If Cherokee NCS or Cherokee EOC is not responding then, go ahead and send directly to NWS if conditions meet the criteria of NWS NCS.
- 3. As needed, the Cherokee ARES EOC Team will break into the NET and share critical information.
- 4. Please send your Winlink Check-In form with accurate coordinates to all addresses listed below for situational awareness. If possible send before 18:00 on Saturday for initial layout of all personnel.
- 5. The following two State NETS are for EMERGENCY Traffic Only: DSTAR REF003A and GA-ARES DRATS Ratflector. Only approved emergency traffic from the County EOC will be transmitted. An example of Emergency traffic is "xxxx County EOC is offline and needs help from the (SOC) State Operations Center." This is not a Training Event, and has ability to affect a large portion of the state, we must remain disciplined here...

- e. Flooding > 6" covering roadway or Streams/River.
